Best types of connections for video calls

- 1. Laptop or Desktop with Direct Ethernet connection
- 2. Laptop or Desktop with a good Wireless signal (I can see my router from my laptop)
- 3. Mobile Phone/Tablet with a good Wireless signal (I can see my Wi-Fi router from device)
- 4. Mobile Phone or Tablet with a strong Data plan connection (Wi-Fi extender or hotspot as well)

Best Web Browsers to use per device

For Windows: Chrome, Firefox and Edge (in order of what's best to use)

For Mac: Safari, Chrome, Firefox (in order of what's best to use)

For iPhone/iPad: Safari, Firefox (soon to be chrome)

For Android: Chrome, Firefox (Safari not supported)

(The higher the Download-Upload MBPS the better, 50ms or lower is best for Latency)

1 Minute Video - Improve Wi-Fi Improve My Wireless Now!

Here are some adjustments you can make to improve Download/Upload and Latency:

- Can you get physically closer to the Wi-Fi router? Always good rule of thumb is to be able to see the wireless router from your computer for the best connection (Or Wi-Fi Extender).
- Turn all other devices not being used onto Airplane Mode

Pre-Call Tips for patients

- If using a phone or tablet, try to place in a cradle and be leave 2 to 3 feet between you and the video camera
- Make sure there are not bright lights behind you
- If anything is blocking the camera, please remove before call.
- Use a headset if possible, best for audio quality
- Image of patient for call: Just before the patient enters the waiting room an image will be taken by the camera to display to provider only, so please know when you hit enter, that's when a quick small image is taken.
